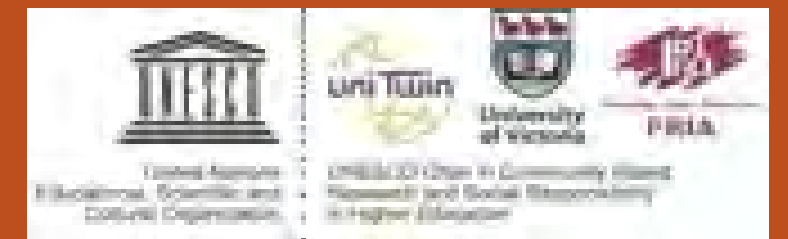

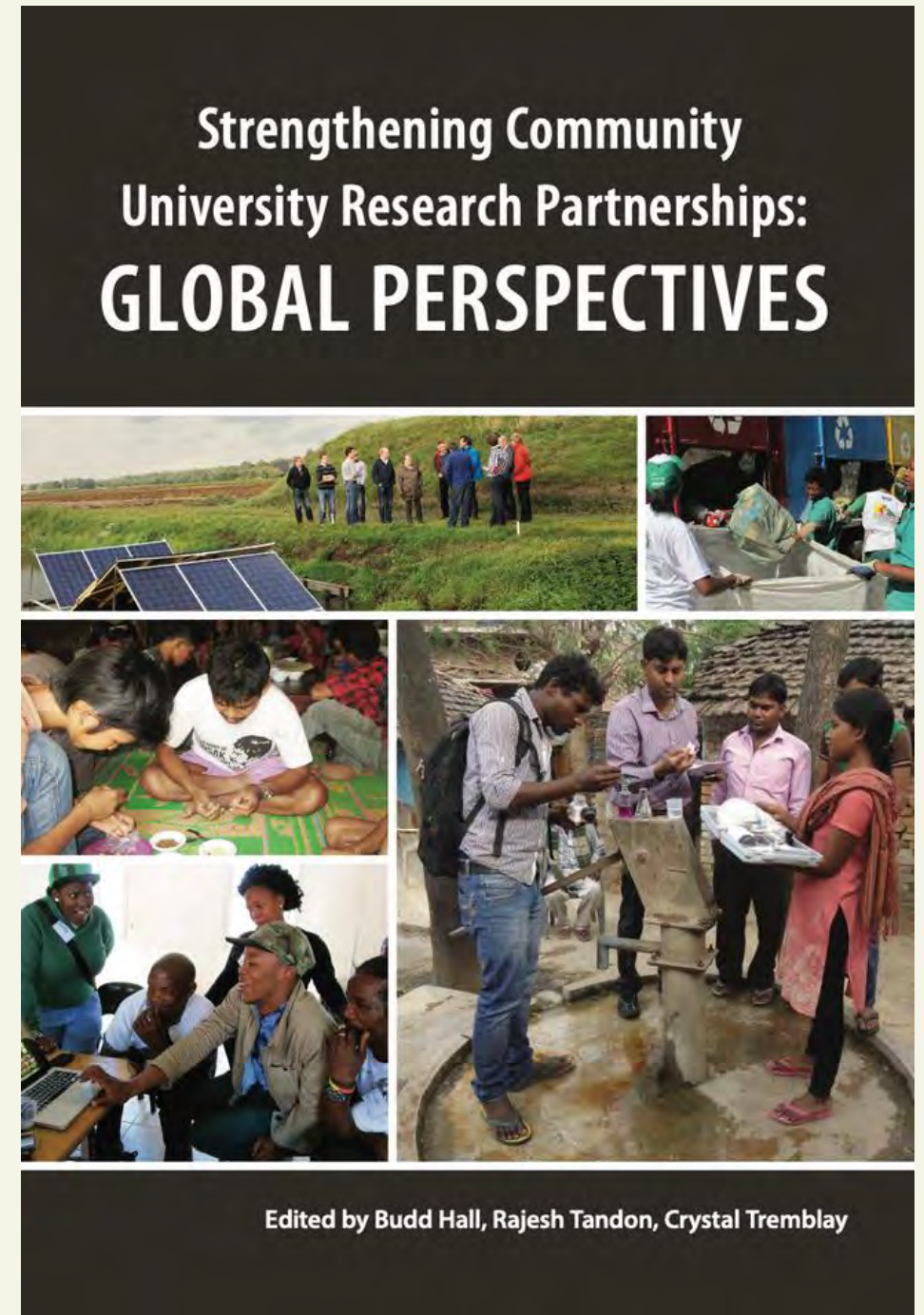
Knowledge for Transformative Change

Openness of Science: Beyond Open Access

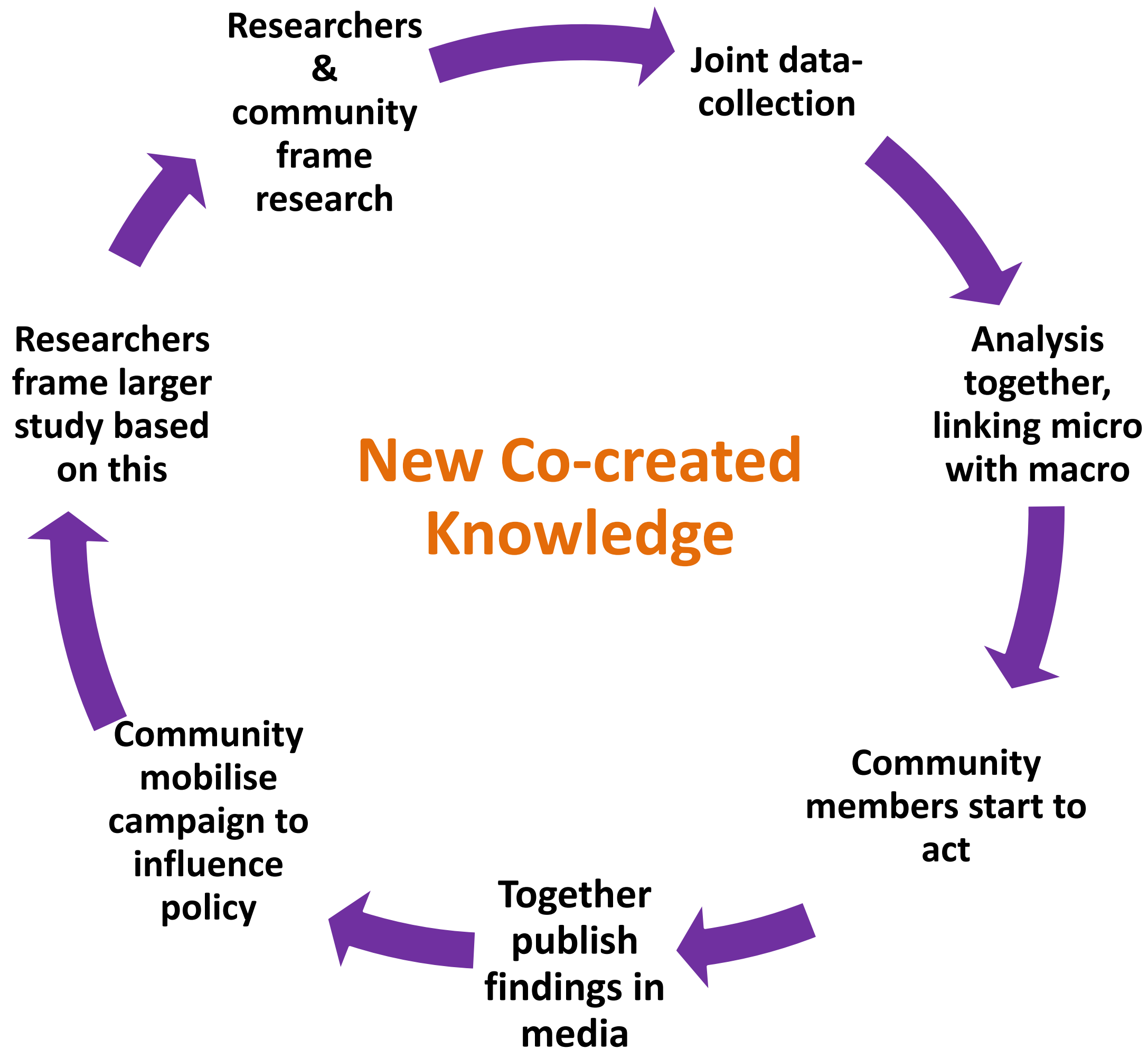
- For-profit 'capture' of knowledge part of knowledge economy

USE MULTIPLE METHODS OF DISSEMINATION OF FINDINGS



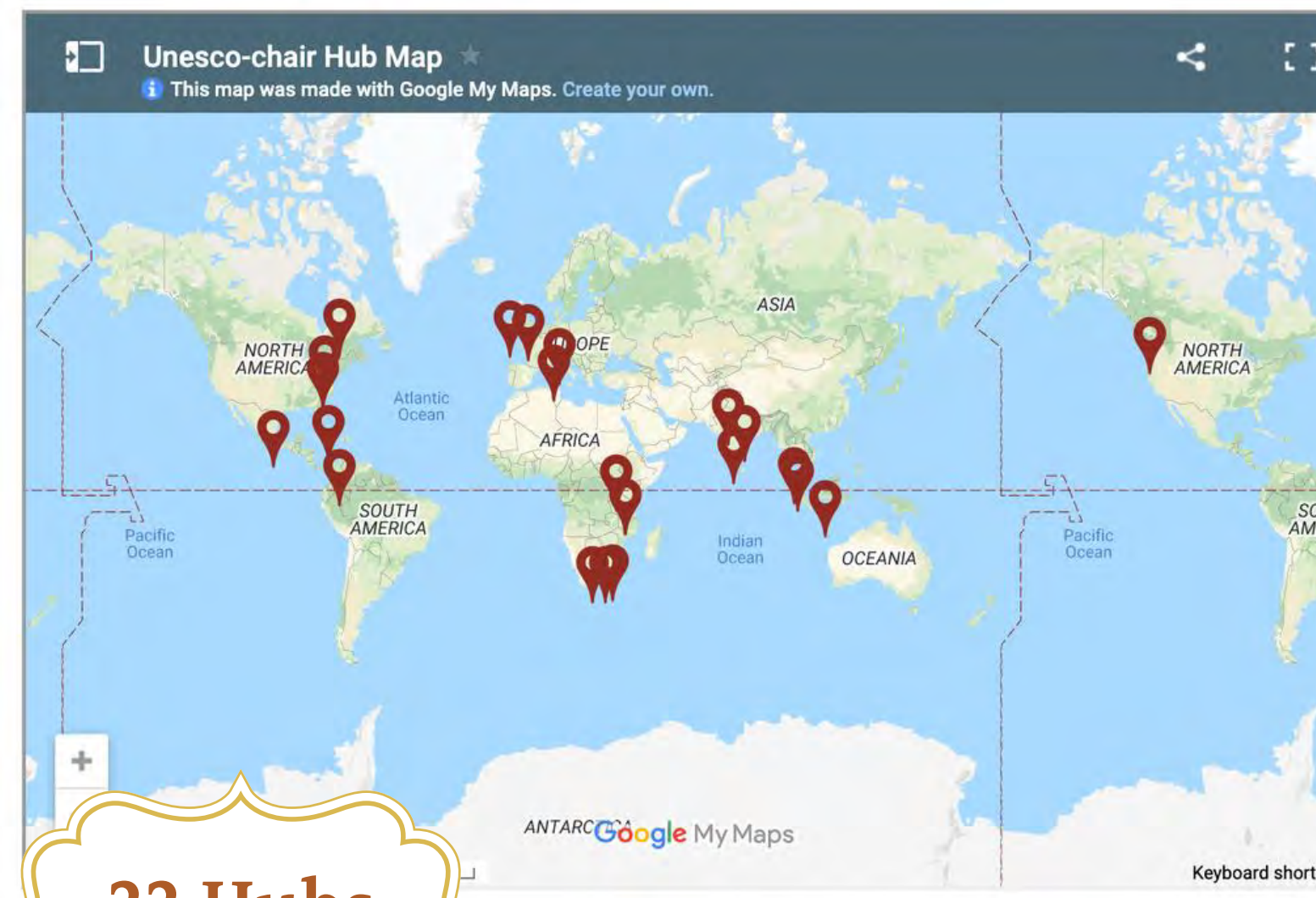

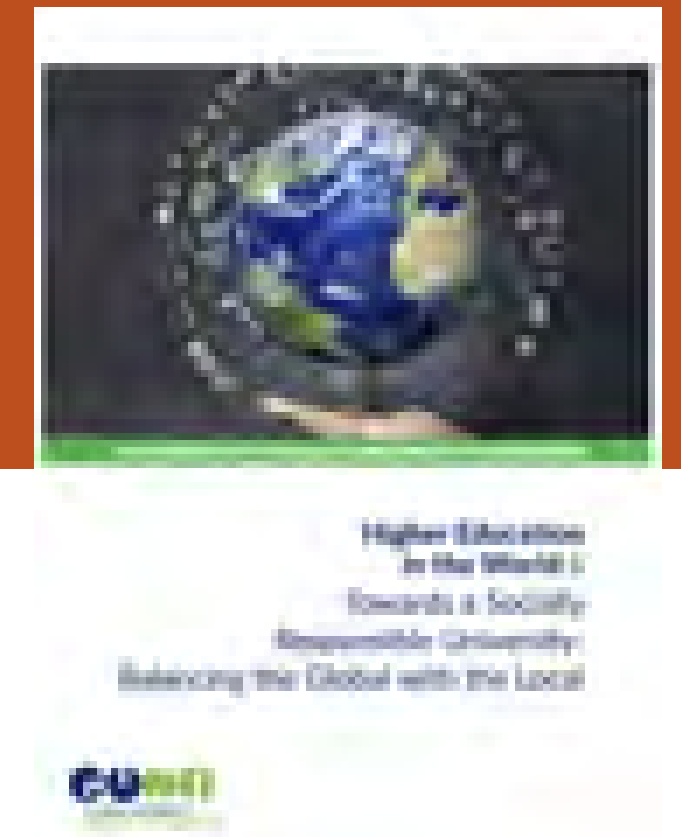
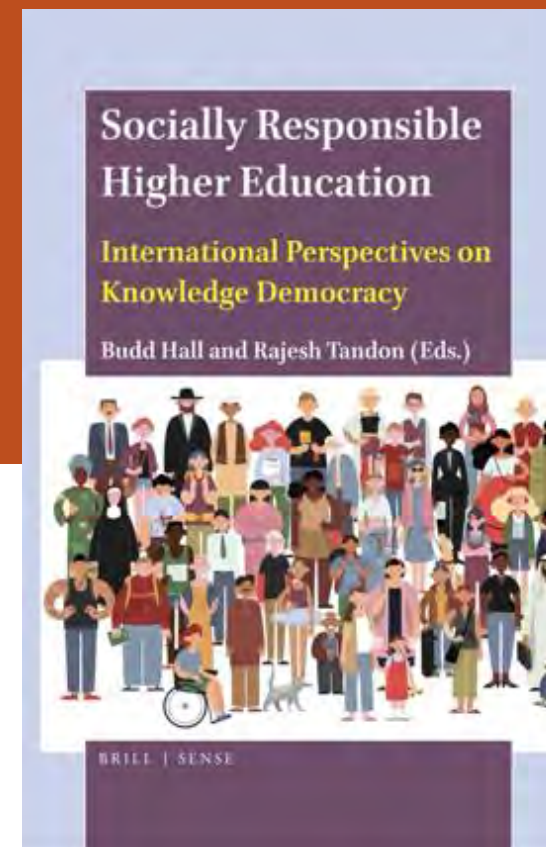
